Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla : India's Space Pioneer



Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla, a distinguished Indian Air Force pilot, stands at the forefront of India's human spaceflight ambitions. As one of the four astronaut-designates for the Gaganyaan mission, he represents India's leap into its first crewed spaceflight.

A highly accomplished test pilot with over 2,000 flying hours on frontline aircraft like the Su-30 MKI and MiG-29, he created history by becoming the first Indian astronaut to visit the International Space Station (ISS) during the Axiom Mission 4 (Ax-4). His extensive training at the Yuri Gagarin Cosmonaut Training Center in Russia and ongoing preparation in India reflect his commitment to excellence.

Shukla's achievements mark a significant milestone for India, offering valuable operational experience and strengthening the nation's indigenous space program.
