- (3) Speech & language therapy.
- (4) Early literacy intervention (reading, writing, numeracy)
- (5) Behavior Concerns for Neurodiverse children (ASD, ADHD, SPD).
- (6) Social skills training.
- (7) Special Education.
- (8) Early intervention services.
- (9) Rehabilitation services for children with hearing loss (Auditory Verbal therapy)
- (10) Periodic consultations with other therapists (SLP, OT). We hope and wish to extend our support to our children and families and lead them to be their “ Personal Best” eaving a life of dignity with high integrity with a sense of safety of belonging.

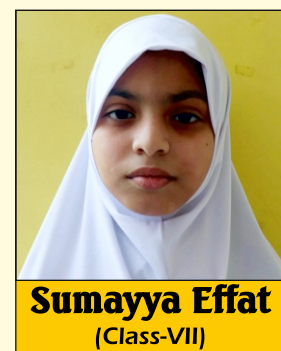
